

Anyone Can Be Addicted. Anyone.

Many prescription painkillers are opioids. They affect the brain and body in very similar ways to Heroin. Misuse of them can lead to addiction and possible overdose.

Opioid Use Disorder (OUD) is an epidemic that knows no boundaries. In Pennsylvania and around the country, opioid addiction affects men and women of all ages, races, and geographic locations equally.

There are research-based approaches to prevention and responses to opioid misuse. **PAStop** was launched in 2016, funded through a grant from the PA Commission on Crime & Delinquency (PCCD) and was designed to educate Pennsylvanians about the risks of prescription painkillers and potential consequences like overdose. The **PAStop** workgroup is made up of state prevention specialists, marketing and advertising professionals, diversity, equity and inclusion consultants, and qualitative analytic evaluators, as well as an expanded group of statewide peer advisors.

Our main mission is to equip and support Pennsylvania's network of prevention workers in the field with FREE high-level, tested, trusted, consistent tools to better promote their many efforts and programs. **PAStop** (and its sister initiative, **PAStart**) are made up of aggregated messaging and materials archives that feature communications resources and tools that have been tested, focus-grouped, and evaluated for efficacy within the many counties and communities in Pennsylvania over the past nine years using multiple industry Best Practices tools. In our catalogued library, we've developed materials that target: Opioid addiction, accidental overdose, workplace policies, safe medication storage and disposal, patient empowerment, prescriber education, parenting assistance, as well as information promoting harm reduction, overdose reversal, recovery, Rx Take Back, awareness and stigma reduction.




